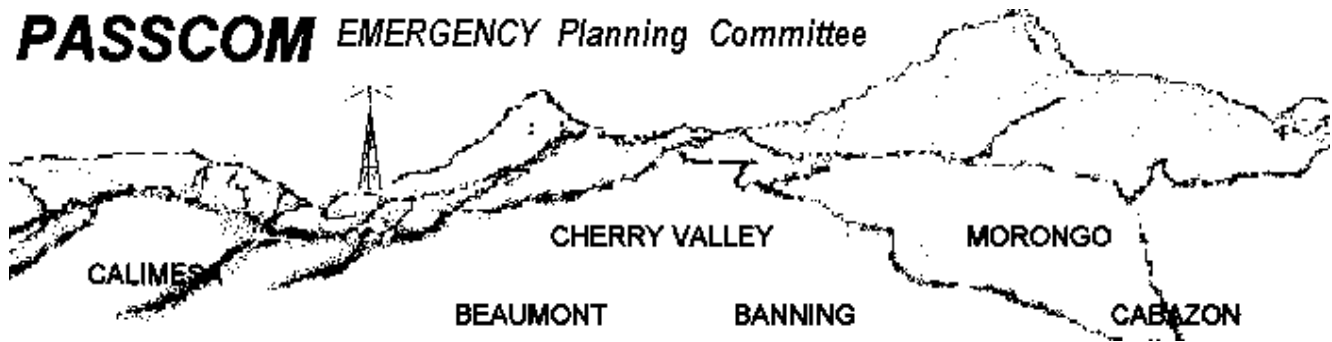


# **PASSCOM** EMERGENCY Planning Committee
